Bell & Howell SYNCHRONIZED REMOTE CONTROL

The new synchronized Remote Control supplied with your movie outfit puts you in complete command of your projector from an easy-chair, or from anywhere in the room. Here's all there is to putting on a show with your new Remote Control...

Set up your projector and screen as described in the accompanying instruction booklet

Plug the end of the Remote
Control cord with the
two prongs into a wall outlet.

Plug the line cord of the projector into the receptacle marked "Projector".

Plug the cord of a bridge or table lamp into the receptacle marked "Room Lamp". This will provide light in the room for threading your projector (see instruction booklet). Important: Make certain the total wattage of the room lamp does not exceed 450 watts.

Once your projector is threaded with film, move the control switch of the projector to "Lamp"

To start your show, mereby press the "Run" cycle button on the Remote Control. This will start the projector and automatically turn off the room light.

After the show is over, or if you want to stop for a break in the middle of a reel, simply press the "OFF" cycle button on the Remote Control. This will turn off the projector and turn the room light on automatically.
